Weather Wonders

IPC

Our topic this half term is 'Weather Wonders'. For this topic we will be learning about the natural world around us.

Maths

We will be building using blocks of different shapes and sizes.

We will sing songs and play games which encourage us to count and recognise numbers.

How can you help me at home?

Play counting games with me, such as counting the number of steps we take, or how many stairs we climb.

Look out for circles, squares, triangles and rectangles on our way to school.
For example; signs, doors, windows.

We will explore, observe and comment on the weather.

We will be looking at festivals and holidays that others may celebrate such as Diwali and Christmas.

We will be developing our confidence in using equipment such as torches and cameras to support learning.

We will experiment by moving in different ways, including climbing and balancing.

We will practise throwing and catching balls.

We will be encouraged to run around safely in the garden and learn how to avoid obstacles.

We will be encouraged to put on our coats, hats, scarves and gloves all by ourselves.
