Literacy

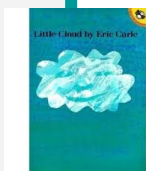
I will be listening and responding to stories about the weather.

I will be encouraged to experiment with a variety of mark making tools and begin to give meaning to my marks.

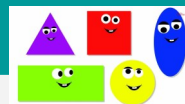
I will practise recognising and writing my name.

I will explore, observe and comment on the changes in the weather and identify what clothes are needed for each weather type.

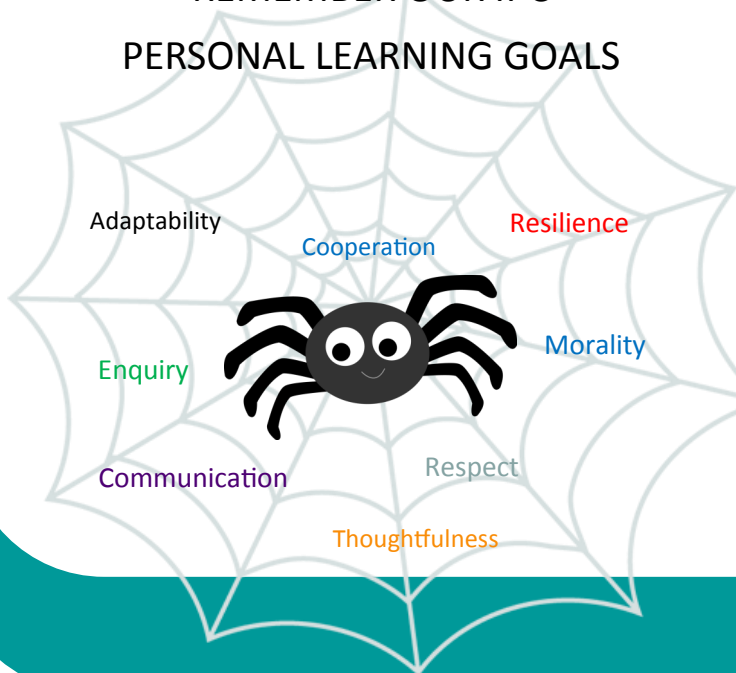
I will be looking at festivals and holidays that others may celebrate such as Diwali and Christmas.
