Time Travellers



Mathematics

In the Autumn term we will be focusing on numbers 0-10 in depth. This is in order to enhance the children's understanding of these numbers. For example: Can children make the number 10 with 3 single digits?

The children will learn to form their numbers correctly and to confidently sequence their numbers by counting forward and back. They will also explore number bonds up to 10.

We will be introducing children to the + - and = signs. Children will be taught concrete and pictorial strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems using their knowledge of number bonds.

How you can help me at home:

Help me practise reading unfamiliar words by helping me break down a word using my phonic knowledge and then blending the sounds.

Help me practise my spellings. Spelling tests will happen every Friday and a new set will be given to the children to take home for the following week.

IPC

Our IPC topic this term is 'Time Travellers'. In History, children will be developing an understanding of timelines and significant events in their own lives, as well as learning about periods in time, historical events and the people linked to them.

In International, children will be learning about celebrations in different countries and the people/events behind these celebrations.

The children will also think about the personal learning goals and how they can demonstrate them in their lives.

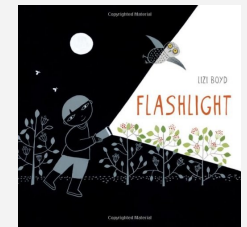

Writing

For the first three weeks of the Autumn term, we will be studying Lizi Boyd's Book 'Flashlight'. Children will develop their descriptive writing skills and write their own adaptation of the story.



Upon completion of the writing weeks, Year One will learn how to write recounts of activities they have taken part in at school and at home. They will learn to orally retell events in chronological order to help them structure their writing.

PE

We will be focusing on cooperative games and different forms of movement in PE.
