

GROW YOUR MIND

Writing

This half term the children will be developing writing skills by writing narrative.

For the two weeks of term children will be focusing on the story 'Owl Babies' to inspire them to write their own stories. We will be changing the characters in the story and publish our finished articles in a class book.

After writing weeks we will be focusing on improving our own work independently. We will look at how to use adjectives and ambitious vocabulary to our writing by editing our work for publication.

Mathematics

This half term in mathematics, children will be developing their understanding of number and expanding their bank of calculation strategies.

Within this unit, children will:

- Compare numbers within 50.
- Continue to use a variety of strategies to add and subtract within 50 including: counting on, using concrete resources (bead strings, number lines and dienes) and using number bonds to 10.
- Solve simple one step word problems for example: Ben has 2 apples and Clare has 3 apples. How many apples are there altogether. We will be focusing on highlighting key words from the question to solve the problem.

How can you help me at home?

Please help me with my weekly maths home learning, practise my 2, 5 and 10 times tables and number bonds to 10. The maths home learning will be given out on a Friday and should be returned on the following Thursday. Please complete this in your purple home learning book. All spelling lists for the half term will be given out at the start of the half term. Spelling tests will be on a Thursday.
