Mathematics

Children will be focusing on deepening their understanding of addition and subtraction of up to 4 digit numbers. We will be further developing our conceptual understanding of multiplication and division; solving problems using both written and mental methods.

Furthermore the children will consolidate their knowledge of bar modelling to help them solve word problems as well as participate in practical Maths activities.

The children will also be working on mental maths strategies on a weekly basis through lesson based teaching as well as daily Maths Meeting tasks focusing on length and perimeter.

READING

Children will participate in daily SFA lessons, learning new reading and comprehension skills. Children will explore different books focusing on unpicking vocabulary, summarising main events and analysing the reader's viewpoint.

The children should keep record their thoughts in their reading journals. The children will be given a focus question to answer as well as making two further comments. Children should take an AR test fortnightly, after reading a suitable book.

IPC

In IPC we will starting our new and exciting topic - Temples, Tombs and Treasures.

In History we will be digging into Ancient Egypt and discovering the hidden treasures that were discovered there. We will focus on pyramids, the River Nile and the gods and goddesses.

In Art we will be creating our own Egyptian wall paintings and applying our knowledge from history lessons to our artistic skills in order to create items to showcase in our Ancient Egyptian gallery at the end of the half term. We will study hieroglyphics and the different symbols that
