The provision has a Nursery Officer who is level 3 qualified and who is and who is responsible for the day to day running of the room. Other room staff either have a level 2 or level 3 qualification.

There is always one member of First Aid qualified staff on the premises.

High quality provision is dependent upon high quality staff. We are committed to fostering a happy, skilled and loyal staff team which ensures that we maintain the highest possible standards.

We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum which places focus on providing an environment which supports children's Communication and Language, Physical and Personal, Social and Emotional Development. They will also access independently all the learning areas within the classroom and outdoor environment. These have been carefully planned to meet the children's needs and interest.

What We Offer

Shacklewell Two Year Old Provision offers part time places in both the morning and the afternoon, Monday to Friday, during term time only. Morning sessions run from **8:30am to 11:30am**, and afternoon sessions from **12:30pm to 3:30pm**.

We currently provide places for up to 24 children, 12 in the morning and 12 in the afternoon. These places are funded places for 2 year olds, dependent on families meeting specific eligibility criteria, which included income benefits and the need for further family support.

How to Apply

Please come into the school office to complete an admissions form. Once the form is completed, the office staff will be able to check your eligibility. If you are eligible for a place, you will be contacted by a member of our staff to provide you with a start date and allocate a home visit.

Drop off & Collection

Please bring your child to the provision in time for the start of their session: **8:30am** for morning children and **12:30pm** for afternoon children, through the main school entrance on Shacklewell Row, then follow signs for the Two Year Old Provision. A member of staff will be there to greet you.



You are welcome to stay with your child, for a period of time, to settle them into their day; perhaps sharing a book with them, or playing alongside them at an activity of their choice.

Each child is unique and we work with families to ensure that the settling process is as pleasant as possible for everyone.

Please ensure you are on time to collect your child from the provision: **11:30am** for morning children and **3:30pm** for afternoon children.

Your child is expected to attend daily. If your child is ill, please ring the front office to let us know.
